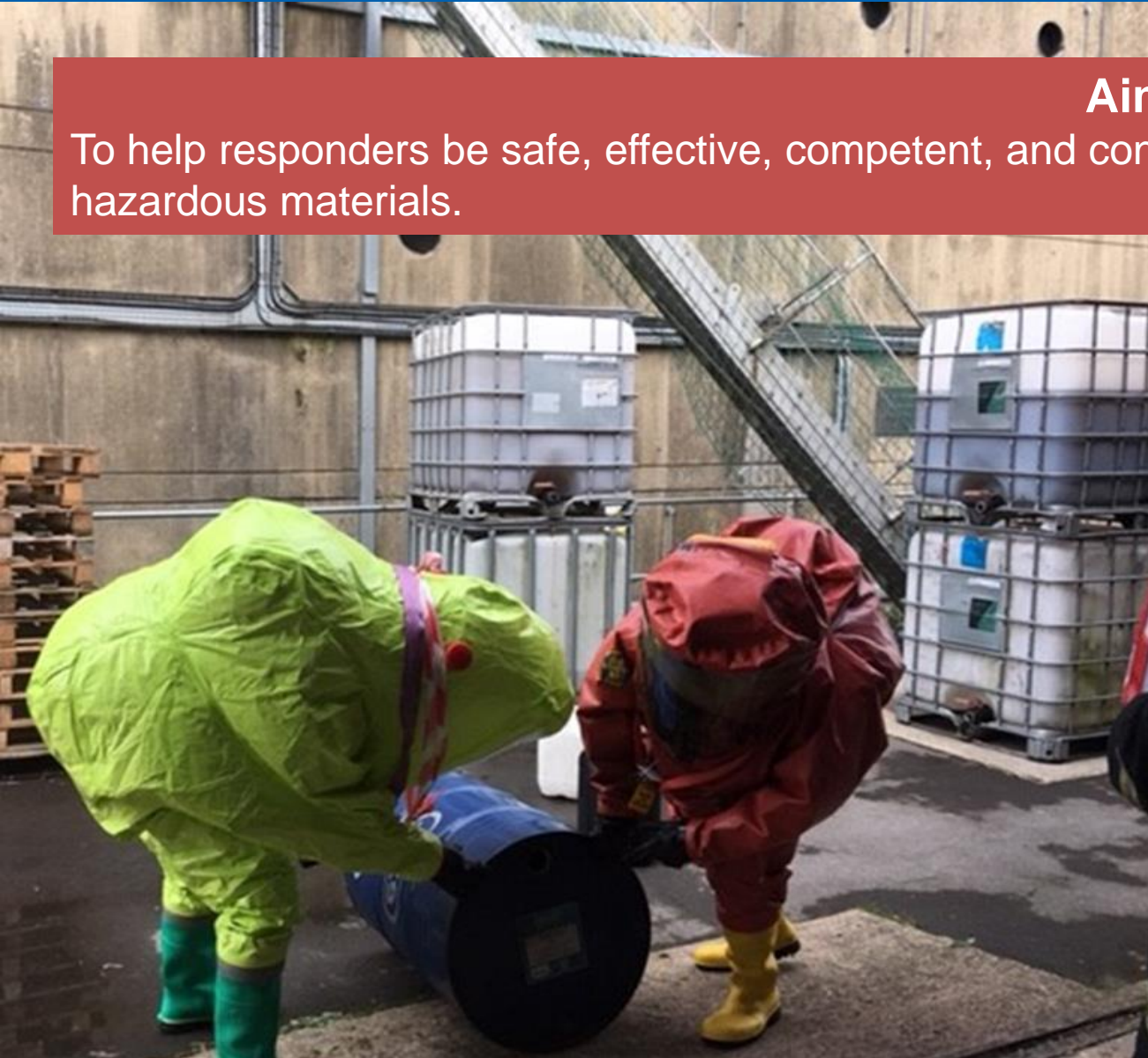

Eight phase approach

Aim

To help responders be safe, effective, competent, and confident during their response to an incident involving hazardous materials.



Recap of phase 1 to 4

Pre-planning and risk awareness

- Risk assessment.
- Situational awareness.
- Hazmat training.

Mobilisation and safe approach

- Vital for first responders.
- Safe approach.
- Information gathering.

Arrival at the incident

- Getting hold of on-scene responsible person.
- Implementing cordons.
- Communication is key.

Tactical planning

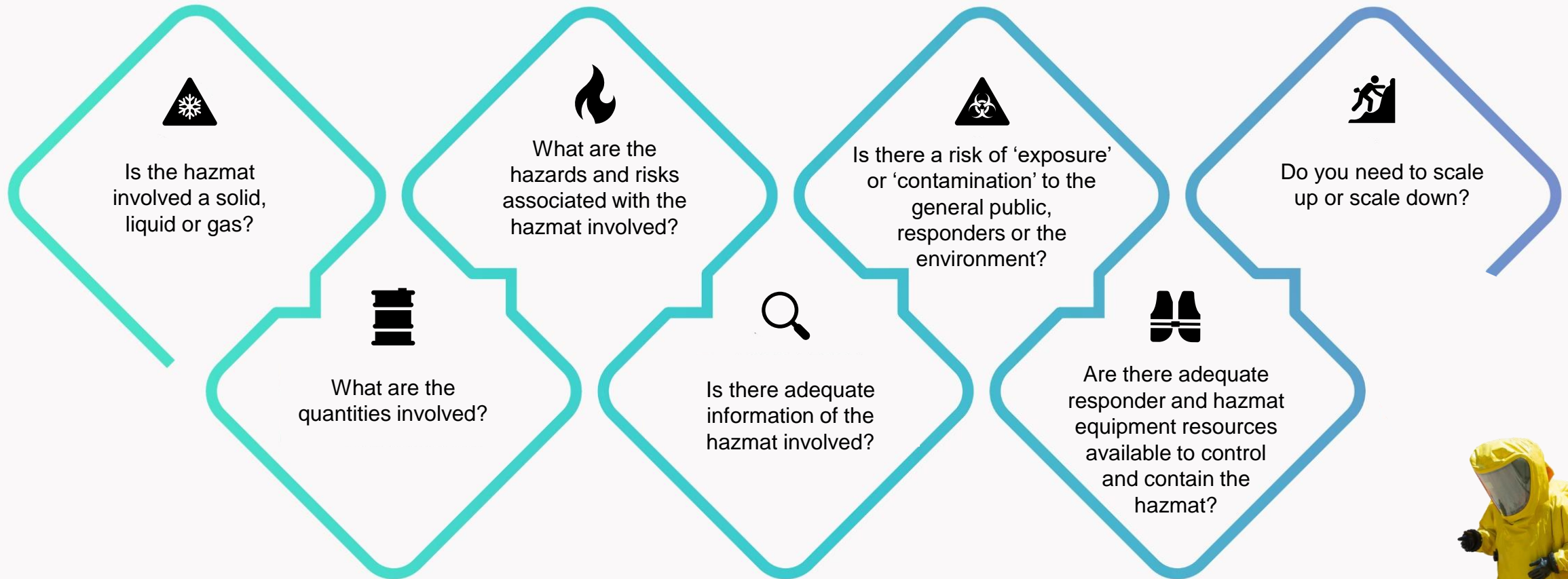
- Tactical plan.
- Available information resources.
- Priority rescues.
- Risk vs benefit analysis.
- Setting up mitigation plans.

Development of the incident

Review the incident

Under control or becoming protracted?



Key takeaways



Stay flexible with your plan and review progress towards bringing the incident under control and possible handover to responsible person on-site.



Liaise with the responsible person on-site and other agencies to provide extra resources and advice on dealing with the incident.



Be aware that the hazards of the material may change over time due to evaporation or decomposition.
